The following Acts of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 5th May, 1977, and are hereby published for general into nation.

ACT No. XVII of 1977.

An Act further to amend certain laws relating to industrial relations and welfare of workers

Whereas it is expedient further to amend certain laws relating to industrial relations and welfare of workers for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. Short title, extent and commencement,—(I) This Act may be called the Labour Laws (Amendment) Act, 1977.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of certain laws. The laws specified in the First Schedule shall be amended in the manner specified in the fourth column thereof.
- 3. Repeal.—The Labour Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977 (IX of 1977), is hereby repealed.
